POWERING A GREENER CHURCH

Breadsall Church is raising funds for a new 3-phase power supply.

All Saints Breadsall has ambitions plans to enhance our beautiful historic building into a warmer, more welcoming and low carbon space for the benefit of church and community.

The plans include a new kitchen, accessible toilets, a meeting room, a low carbon heating system, and an array of solar PV panels on the south-facing roof. We also hope to add one or more Electric Vehicle charging points for village use.

To move forward with the kitchen, new electric-powered heating, solar panels, and EV charging, we will need a substantial 3-phase electricity supply (3 \times 100 Amps) to replace the old 60 Amp service installed in the 1950s.

The new connection from the National Grid, plus internal re-wiring, has been costed at over £20,000.

As part of their 2030 Net Zero commitment, the Church of England has generously granted All Saints up to £10,000 from their *Give-to-go-Green* Fund, but only if we can match them pound for pound within a 6-week fund-raising window. With your generosity, plus any Gift Aid added on top, we are optimistic that we can reach our full funding target.
